RICK: I nearly forgotten about this as I've been busy with other things, but there's this property deed that I purchased on Ebay a couple of years ago. It mentions a Jacob Berkheiser and since there's one in your line this might be of interest to you.

The deed is an 11 by 17 inch page that was apparently cut out of an old deed book. Dated March 10, 1895. It really doesn't mention much by way of vitals except it has Robert Wilson vs. William Mackey and Jacob Berkheiser. The thing that gets me is the township of Loyalsock. Is there such a place in Pennsylvania? Those of you that live in PA, would any of you know?

BRENDA PHILLIPS: Loyalsock Township is in Lycoming County, Pennsylvania. It is near Williamsport. Hope that helps!


RICK: Thanks! That solves the other two words I couldn't make out. Bought the thing on Ebay for \$9.95. If I can't find its proper home, I was thinking of having it mounted somehow to preserve it.

rick: Loyalsock township is part of Williamsport Pa which is a few miles south of Trout Run Pa. Loyalsock, is named after the Creek of the same name as is Trout run named after a creek of the same name. They both enter the upper west branch of the Susquehanna River. Geography helps in this region because Lumber and timber were very big industries.

TOM: One of my Great Uncles was named Jacob Berkheiser, and he is mentioned in the History of Cogan House Township, he built the largest barn in Lycoming, County, near Williamsport. It's just north of Williamsport.

He was a brother to my Great Grandfather, John Berkheiser, who lived in Trevorton, Pa., in the heart of the coal region.

He had a couple of sons, one of which moved to the state of Indiana, and then into Michigan, as far as I can





remember.

They were involved in the birch bark industry, boiling it, and making it into something medicinal.

I have the book the History of Cogan House Township, now out of print.

I remember going to a house in Trout Run, Pa., just north on route 15 from Williamsport, and I was only about 6-years-old, and I recently went back to Trout Run, went up to that house in the small development, and asked the current owner if he knew if his house at one time was owned by a Jacob Berkheiser.

He got the funniest look on his face, and told me to come it. He took me upstairs and showed me the inside walls of the house, as they had been removed, and he was remodeling it.

In almost all of the walls, all on 16-inch centers, it said in writing, this house built by Jacob Berkheiser. I also went to the cemetery in Trout Run, Pa., and there are a lot of Berkheisers buried there, although I don't know the relationship of them. But, one thing I know for a certainty, they are all related to me. But, unfortunately, they are all dead now.

One of Jacob's sons Lester Berkheiser had a son, and I delved into it, and found that he now had a different name, as he was adopted by his Grandfather on his mother's side, and the name was Golder. His son's name was Deemer Golder, and he recently died. Although I did have the opportunity to meet his daughter, and she didn't even know that she was a relative to the Berkheisers.

Well, I guess I've rambled long enough, so I'll run. Don't mind if you send this to other Berkheisers, or any that is interested in this genealogy.
