He came to West Virginia where he met and married Jemima McCulty, whose people came from Calhoun County. They were the parents of eight children, Talmage, Gay, Lydia, Esty, Ethel, Mary, freer, and Frank. Frank (residing in Akron, Ohio) and Ethel (85 years old and residing in Baldwin, West Virginia) are still living. They wanted to secure a place where we children could get an education. So in June 1891 they came to Glenville where he set up a shop on Bridge Street. There he did carpentry work, such as wagons, sleds, buggies and other things. He worked at this until he helped lay the pipe for the water company. When all pipes were laid the company hired him where he worked as an engineer for 21 years. He and Frank were coming home from work when he suffered a heart attack and died. Of the children, six

earned a diploma, five as teachers and one as a druggist. Alva Esty, the druggist, earned his license as a druggist at Morgantown. He first worked for James Tierney. Then he bought the store and worked there till he retired. Then he worked for Mr. Goff Summers til lhe died on April 4, 1970. Gilmer County History.

It rained so much in the days prior to Albert's funeral that his coffin had to be transported by paddle boat to the cemetery, where his grave had half filled with water (Evalyn Stottlemire Peeples, granddaughter). Last Rites for Mrs. Berkhouse Held Saturday. Interment Made in Stalnaker Cemetery Below Glenville. Mrs. Araminta McCulty Berkhouse was born in Calhoun County on April 1, 1859. She perished in the flames that consumer her home in Glenville, on December 22, 1932, at the age of 73 years and eight months. She was the fourth child of a family of five children. The early part of her life was spent on her father's farm in Calhoun County where she attended public school. When yet a young woman she united with the Methodist Episcopal Church at Linden, Roane County. Throughout the remainder of her life she was a staunch church worker, taking active part in the work of the Ladies Aid and the Bible classes. In 1884, at the age of twenty-five she was united in marriage to Albert Franklin Berkhouse of Calhoun County, a wagon-maker by trade. The family moved to Gilmer County 42 years ago. In 1905 Mr. Berkhouse became engineer for the Glenville Water and Light Co. He held this position until the time of his death, Nov. 13, 1925. Eight children were born to this union: Talmadge, of near Salem, Doddridge County; Freer, of near Columbus, Ohio; Mrs. Gay Strader and Mrs. Lydia Guy, both of Barberton, Ohio; Mrs. Minter Berry and A. Esty Berkhouse of Glenville; Frank at home and Miss Mary who died some ten years ago. In her own family Mrs. Berkhouse leaves to mourn her passing three brothers: John McCulty of McCulty of Akron, Ohio; the Rev. R. S. McCulty of Newburg, and one sister, Mrs. Mary Simmons, of Spencer. Funeral services were held at the Glenville Methodist Episcopal Church Saturday afternoon, December 24, at three o'clock, with the Rev. W. W. Sutton, pastor of the church, in charge.
